

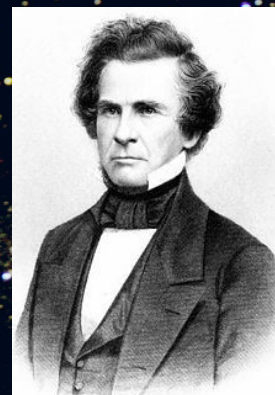
# 2019 Spring Meeting

May 11th 2019



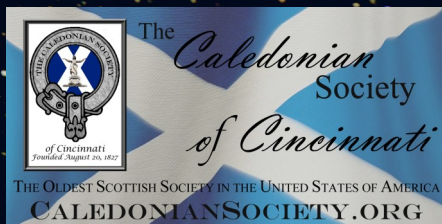
Join us at the "Birthplace of American Astronomy"
